Covid 19 Vaccinations


Patients are now able to book for their Covid Vaccinations through the National Booking System on the NHS Website. Patients, who do not have access to the internet, can call 119 service to book on their behalf.

Pharmacy Referral – DID YOU KNOW?

You can now be referred for an NHS Community Pharmacist Consultation Service, for Lower Acuity Conditions such as Colds, Congestion, Ear or Eye Problems and many more. This can be offered as a Face to Face or Telephone Consultation if you are unable to get an appointment with the GP.

Physiotherapist:

Our GPs can refer to our in House Physiotherapist for patients who have a variety of conditions.

Pharmacist: We have two Clinical Pharmacists linked to the surgery who mainly deal with Medication Reviews and Minor Ailments and Asthma Reviews.

Care Coordinator: Our Care Coordinator reviews patients' needs to help them access services that will support them and help them understand how to manage their own care and wellbeing. This may involve referring patients for Smoking Cessation to encourage patients to stop smoking, or involve referring them to Social Prescribing where patients are advised on help with things such as Mental Health, Social Isolation, Substance Misuse and many more.
